1 2	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for driving without a license.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Section 1501(d) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
6	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
7	§ 1501. Drivers required to be licensed.
8	* * *
9	(d) Penalty <u>Any person violating subsection (c) is guilty</u>
10	of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to
11	pay a fine of \$200 for each license beyond one. Any person
12	violating subsection (a) is guilty of a summary offense and
13	shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$200,
14	except that, if the person charged furnishes satisfactory proof
15	of having held a driver's license valid on the last day of the
16	preceding driver's license period and no more than one year has
17	elapsed from the last date for renewal, the fine shall be \$25.

1 No person charged with violating subsection (a) or (b) shall be 2 convicted if the person produces at the office of the issuing 3 authority within five days of the violation:

4 (1) a driver's license valid in this Commonwealth at the 5 time of the violation; or

6 (2) if the driver's license is lost, stolen, destroyed 7 or illegible, evidence that the driver was licensed at the 8 time of the violation.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
