| 11 | major manufacturing center in the early 18th century for paper, |
| 12 | iron, leather, glass and power; and |

| 14 | Cameron Sproul, Governor of Pennsylvania 1919-1923; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, Nether Providence Township was the first township to |
| 16 | establish a zoning code and had the first workable railroad in |
