A RESOLUTION

- 1 Encouraging dairy farmers to become members of the Regional
- 2 Cooperative Marketing Agency, Inc.
- 3 WHEREAS, There is a need for Pennsylvania farmers to
- 4 voluntarily cooperate in marketing efforts to improve their
- 5 economic well-being; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Regional Cooperative Marketing Agency, Inc.
- 7 (RCMA), a corporate entity of 11 northeastern states, provides a
- 8 medium through which dairy farmers may work cooperatively to
- 9 improve marketing returns from their dairy production; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Ninety percent of Pennsylvania's dairy farmers have
- 11 agreed to become members of RCMA; and
- 12 WHEREAS, In order for the program to be most effective, a
- 13 goal of 95% of Pennsylvania dairy farmers becoming RCMA members
- 14 is desired; and
- WHEREAS, Improvement in the economic well-being of the dairy
- 16 industry in general, and the dairy producers specifically, is of
- 17 major importance to the economy of the region; therefore be it

- 1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 2 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania support the present dairy farmer
- 3 initiative to implement the purposes of the Regional Cooperative
- 4 Marketing Agency, Inc., and thus benefit the economy of the
- 5 region; and be it further
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage dairy
- 7 farmers to become members of the Regional Cooperative Marketing
- 8 Agency, Inc.
