A RESOLUTION

1 Requesting the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to review and
2 reconsider certain actions relating to the reduction or
3 elimination of certain discounts.

4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board, on November
5 14, 1988, issued a series of rulings which reduced retail
6 licensee purchase discounts from 12 1/2% to 7% and eliminated
7 certain retail bulk purchase discounts; and

8 WHEREAS, The affected discounts had been longstanding
9 Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board policy on which retailers and
10 purchasers formulated budgetary plans and relied upon to enter
11 into various contractual arrangements; and

12 WHEREAS, The action of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board
13 has had and will continue to have an adverse effect on retail
14 licensees and consumers; therefore be it

15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives respectfully
16 requests the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to reconsider and
17 further review its rulings on discounts and, during such review,
18 to retain the discounts to the levels in effect prior to
19 November 14, 1988; and be it further

2 the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.
