A RESOLUTION

- 1 Requesting the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to review and
- 2 reconsider certain actions relating to the reduction or
- 3 elimination of certain discounts.
- 4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board, on November
- 5 14, 1988, issued a series of rulings which reduced retail
- 6 licensee purchase discounts from 12 1/2% to 7% and eliminated
- 7 certain retail bulk purchase discounts; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The affected discounts had been longstanding
- 9 Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board policy on which retailers and
- 10 purchasers formulated budgetary plans and relied upon to enter
- 11 into various contractual arrangements; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The action of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board
- 13 has had and will continue to have an adverse effect on retail
- 14 licensees and consumers; therefore be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives respectfully
- 16 requests the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to reconsider and
- 17 further review its rulings on discounts and, during such review,
- 18 to retain the discounts to the levels in effect prior to
- 19 November 14, 1988; and be it further
