A SUPPLEMENT

To the act of July 3, 1987 (P.L.459, No.9A), entitled "An act to 2 provide from the General Fund for the expenses of the 3 Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1987, to June 30, 1988, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close 5 6 7 of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1987; to provide appropriations from the Lottery Fund, the Pennsylvania Economic Revitalization Fund and the Energy Conservation and 9 Assistance Fund to the Executive Department; to provide for 10 the appropriation of Federal funds to the Executive and 11 12 Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth and for the establishment of restricted receipts accounts for the fiscal 13 14 year July 1, 1987, to June 30, 1988, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the 15 16 fiscal year ending June 30, 1987; itemizing appropriations 17 required from the Motor License Fund for the fiscal year July 18 1, 1987, to June 30, 1988, for the proper operation of the 19 several departments of the Commonwealth authorized to spend Motor License Fund moneys; and to further provide from the 20 21 General Fund for the expenses of the Executive Department and 22 Judicial Department of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1986, to June 30, 1987, and for the payment of bills incurred and 23 24 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 25 26 30, 1986, making supplemental appropriations; imposing 27 additional restrictions on the appropriations for the Human 28 Services Development Fund; and making repeals.
