## AN ACT

- 1 Creating the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Council; prescribing 2 duties; and establishing a fund.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Vietnam
- 7 Veterans' Memorial Council Act.
- 8 Section 2. Legislative findings.
- 9 (a) Recognition of contributions. -- The General Assembly
- 10 recognizes the great contributions and unselfish sacrifices made
- 11 by Pennsylvania service people during the Vietnam Conflict.
- 12 (b) Absence of memorial.--The General Assembly further

- 1 recognizes that no adequate, appropriate and permanent memorial
- 2 has ever been erected in appreciation of and in tribute to those
- 3 Pennsylvania service people who gave devoted and dedicated
- 4 service to their country and this Commonwealth.
- 5 (c) Erection of memorial. -- The General Assembly believes
- 6 that, in consideration of the foregoing, a positive, permanent
- 7 and patriotic memorial should be erected on State grounds or
- 8 property owned by the Commonwealth in appreciation of the full
- 9 measure of devotion given by Vietnam veteran service people.
- 10 Section 3. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 "Council." The Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Council created by
- 15 this act.
- 16 "Fund." The Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Trust Fund
- 17 established by this act.
- 18 Section 4. Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Council.
- 19 (a) Establishment.--There is hereby established the Vietnam
- 20 Veterans' Memorial Council to undertake, supervise and
- 21 coordinate the design, selection and erection, on State grounds
- 22 or property owned by the Commonwealth, of an appropriately
- 23 patriotic and positive physical monument or memorial as a
- 24 testament of appreciation from the Commonwealth to those
- 25 Pennsylvania service persons who served in the Republic of
- 26 Vietnam during the Vietnam Conflict period.
- 27 (b) Composition of council.--The council shall be composed
- 28 of the following:
- 29 (1) The duly elected president of the Veterans of the
- 30 Vietnam War, or his designee.

- 1 (2) The duly elected president of the Vietnam Veterans
- 2 of America.
- 3 (3) The duly elected president of the Paralyzed Veterans
- 4 of America.
- 5 (4) One nonvoting member, appointed by the Governor, who
- 6 shall be an architect.
- 7 (5) One nonvoting member, appointed by the Governor, who
- 8 shall be a certified public accountant.
- 9 (c) Terms.--All members shall serve for a period of three
- 10 years from the date of their appointment.
- 11 (d) Organization and procedure.--
- 12 (1) The council shall meet initially within 90 days
- 13 after the effective date of this act and shall elect, by a
- 14 majority of all its members, a chairman, vice chairman and a
- 15 secretary from among its members, each to serve for a term of
- three years.
- 17 (2) A majority of all the members of the council shall
- 18 constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
- 19 (3) The council may adopt rules for its government,
- 20 organization and procedures, not inconsistent with the
- 21 provisions of this act.
- (e) Expenses. -- Council members shall receive no compensation
- 23 for their services but shall be reimbursed as hereinafter
- 24 provided for all necessary travel and other reasonable expenses
- 25 incurred in connection with the performance of their duties as
- 26 members of the council.
- 27 Section 5. Duties of council.
- 28 In addition to other powers conferred by this act, the
- 29 council shall have the power:
- 30 (1) To develop a comprehensive plan and design for a

- 1 physical monument, to be located on State grounds or property
- 2 owned by the Commonwealth, honoring Vietnam veterans.
- 3 (2) To coordinate and supervise the gathering of various
- 4 designs for the monument, to make a final design selection
- 5 and to select an appropriate physical site for erection of
- 6 the monument on State grounds or property owned by the
- 7 Commonwealth.
- 8 (3) To receive, for and on behalf of the Commonwealth,
- 9 monetary gifts or bequests which shall be deposited in the
- 10 Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Trust Fund.
- 11 (4) To accept grants and subsidies from and enter into
- agreements or other transactions with any Federal agency or
- agency of the Commonwealth or other entity.
- 14 (5) To enter into contracts and to execute all
- instruments necessary or convenient for carrying on its
- 16 operations.
- 17 (6) To issue appropriate regulations for the
- implementation of this act.
- 19 (7) To do all other things necessary or convenient to
- 20 carry out the powers granted to it by this act.
- 21 Section 6. Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Trust Fund.
- 22 (a) Establishment and administration.--There is hereby
- 23 established a separate fund in the State Treasury to be known as
- 24 the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Trust Fund. The fund shall be
- 25 administered by the State Treasurer.
- 26 (b) Purpose. -- The moneys in the fund shall be used for the
- 27 design and selection of an appropriate physical monument to be
- 28 erected on State grounds or property owned by the Commonwealth
- 29 and other costs incidental thereto.
- 30 (c) Contributions and solicitation of funds.--

- 1 (1) The State Treasurer is hereby authorized:
- 2 (i) To accept, on behalf of the Commonwealth, gifts,
- donations, legacies and usages of money from individuals,
- 4 organizations, public or private corporations and other
- 5 similar entities.
- 6 (ii) To solicit and raise moneys from public and
- 7 private sources.
- 8 (2) All moneys received or raised under this subsection
- 9 shall be paid into the State Treasury and credited to the
- 10 fund.
- 11 Section 7. Expenditure of funds prohibited.
- 12 No taxpayer funds shall be expended for the design, selection
- 13 or erection of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial.
- 14 Section 8. General repeal.
- 15 All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar as they are
- 16 inconsistent with this act.
- 17 Section 9. Expiration.
- 18 This act expires in three years, unless extended by statute.
- 19 Section 10. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately.
