## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.637, No.329), entitled 2 "An act relating to the payment of wages or compensation for labor or services; providing for regular pay days; conferring powers and duties upon the Department of Labor and Industry, 3 4 5 including powers and duties with respect to the civil collection of wages; providing civil and criminal penalties for violations of the act; providing for their collection and disposition and providing for additional civil damages," 8 9 prohibiting the designation by an employer of a particular 10 bank for direct deposit of employee paychecks. 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.637, 14 No.329), known as the Wage Payment and Collection Law, is 15 amended by adding a subsection to read: Section 3. Regular Payday. -- \* \* \* 16 17 (c) Direct deposit. An employer shall not designate a particular bank for the direct deposit of its employe paychecks. 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 19
