AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for left turns.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Section 3331(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

7 § 3331. Required position and method of turning.

8 * * *

9 (b) Left turn.--The driver of a vehicle intending to turn
10 left shall approach the turn in the extreme left-hand lane
11 lawfully available to traffic moving in the direction of travel
12 of the vehicle. On two-lane, two-way streets or highways, left
13 turns shall be made from as close to the center line as
14 possible. Whenever practicable, the left turn shall be made to
15 the left of the center of the intersection and so as to leave
16 the intersection or location in the extreme left-hand lane
17 lawfully available to traffic moving in the same direction as

1 the vehicle on the roadway being entered.

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
