AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, defining the offense of flight to 3 avoid prosecution. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 7 § 5126. Flight to avoid prosecution. 8 9 A person who moves or travels or secretes himself with intent to avoid prosecution for or, after conviction, to avoid custody 10 11 or confinement for a crime, including an attempt to commit a crime, commits: 12 13 (1) A felony of the first degree when the crime with which the person was charged or of which he was convicted is 14 punishable by death or is a felony of the first degree. 15 16 (2) A felony of the third degree when the crime with

which the person was charged or of which he was convicted is

a felony of the second or third degree.

- (3) A misdemeanor of the third degree when the crime 1
- 2 with which the person was charged or of which he was
- convicted is a misdemeanor of the first, second or third 3
- degree. 4
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 5
