AN ACT

1 Amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, further defining "correction officer";  
3 and making an editorial change.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. The definition of "correction officer" in section  
7 5102 of Title 71 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is  
8 amended to read:

9 § 5102. Definitions.

10 The following words and phrases as used in this part, unless  
11 a different meaning is plainly required by the context, shall  
12 have the following meanings:

14 "Correction officer." Any full-time employee assigned to the  
15 Department of Corrections or the Department of Public Welfare

1 whose principal duty is the care, custody and control or direct  
2 therapeutic treatment of inmates of a penal or correctional  
3 institution [or], community treatment center, facility for the  
4 criminally insane or secure unit of a youth development center  
5 operated by the [Bureau of Correction] Department of Corrections  
6 or by the Department of Public Welfare.

7 \* \* \*

8 Section 2. Within 30 days after the effective date of this  
9 act, the Department of Corrections and the Department of Public  
10 Welfare shall certify to the State Employees' Retirement Board a  
11 list of new employees qualified under this act.

12 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
