## AN ACT

- Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for limitation of actions relating to conversion and theft of timber.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 5526 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
- 9 § 5526. Five year limitation.
- 10 The following actions and proceedings must be commenced
- 11 within five years:
- 12 \* \* \*
- 13 (5) An action for conversion of timber.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall apply to actions that are
- 15 commenced on or after the effective date of this act.
- 16 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
