7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
8	hereby enacts as follows:	
9	Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be	<
10	necessary, are specifically appropriated from the restricted	
11	revenue account within the General Fund and from Federal	
12	augmentation funds to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission	
13	to provide for the operation of the commission for the fiscal	
14	year July 1, 1988, to June 30, 1989, for the purposes and in the	
15	amounts shown:

18	and all necessary expenses for the	

1	proper operation and administration	
2	of the Pennsylvania Public Utility

5	(i) The following Federal	
6	augmentation amounts, or as	
7	much thereof as may be	
8	necessary, are specifically	
9	appropriated to supplement the	
10	sum authorized to be billed to	
11	utilities for the operation of	
12	the commission:

14	Pipeline Safety" To	
15	enforce the regulations of

2	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1989, or		
3	immediately, whichever is later.

25	FUNDING IS PROVIDED FOR CURRENT
26	VACANCIES AND FOR TEN NEW ENFORCEMENT

28	STATE APPROPRIATION 3,964,000
29	SECTION 2. THE SUM OF \$2,964,000 IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED FROM
30	THE RESTRICTED REVENUE ACCOUNT WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND TO THE

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- 1 OFFICE OF CONSUMER ADVOCATE TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATION OF THAT
- 2 OFFICE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1989, TO JUNE 30, 1990.
- 3 SECTION 3. (A) THE SUM OF \$503,000 IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED
- 4 FROM THE RESTRICTED REVENUE ACCOUNT WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND TO
- 5 THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 6 COMMERCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATION OF THAT OFFICE FOR THE
- FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1989, TO JUNE 30, 1990, AND FOR REPAYMENT OF 7
- THE \$250,000 APPROPRIATED FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE
- OPERATION OF THAT OFFICE IN THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30,
- 10 1989.
- 11 (B) DUE TO THE LACK OF ANY MEANINGFUL CASE DATA FOR CALENDAR
- 12 YEAR 1988 FOR THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE, THE
- 13 PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION SHALL FOR PURPOSES OF
- 14 LEVYING THE PUBLIC UTILITY ASSESSMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1989-1990,
- 15 USE THE CASE DATA DERIVED FROM THE OFFICE OF CONSUMER ADVOCATE
- 16 FOR THE 1988 CALENDAR YEAR IN ORDER TO DETERMINE THE ASSESSMENTS
- 17 FOR THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE.
- 18 SECTION 4. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT JULY 1, 1989, OR
- 19 IMMEDIATELY, WHICHEVER IS LATER.
