A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, further providing for vacancies in office
- 3 involving members of the General Assembly.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That section 2 of Article II be amended to read:
- 9 § 2. Election of members; vacancies.
- 10 Members of the General Assembly shall be chosen at the
- 11 general election every second year. Their term of service shall
- 12 begin on the first day of December next after their election.
- 13 Whenever a vacancy shall occur in either House, the presiding
- 14 officer thereof shall, within 14 days of the initial occurrence
- 15 of the vacancy, issue a writ of election to fill such vacancy
- 16 for the remainder of the term. In the case of a vacancy
- 17 occurring during the last five months of the term of office of

- 1 the member, issuance of a writ of election shall be at the total
- 2 <u>discretion of the presiding officer.</u>
