## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 11, 1971 (P.L.104, No.3), entitled, as amended, "An act providing property tax or rent rebate and inflation dividends to certain senior citizens, widows, widowers and permanently disabled persons with limited incomes; establishing uniform standards and qualifications for eligibility to receive rebates and dividends; providing for transportation assistance grants and grants to area agencies on aging for services to older persons; and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue," further providing for the maximum rebate for each household.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section 4(b) of the act of March 11, 1971
(P.L.104, No.3), known as the Senior Citizens Rebate and

Assistance Act, reenacted and amended December 21, 1979
(P.L.570, No.131) and amended March 10, 1982 (P.L.177, No.56), is amended to read:

Section 4. Property Tax; Rent Rebate and Inflation Cost.--*

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Section 2. This act shall apply to rebates for rent and property taxes due and payable for the 1989 calendar year.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
