AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for restriction of
- 3 motor vehicle operating privileges.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The heading and subsection (a) of section 6310.4
- 7 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are
- 8 amended to read:
- 9 § 6310.4. Restriction of operating [privileges] privilege.
- 10 (a) General rule.--Whenever a person is convicted or is
- 11 adjudicated delinquent or is admitted to any preadjudication
- 12 program for a violation of section 6307 (relating to
- 13 misrepresentation of age to secure liquor or malt or brewed
- 14 beverages), 6308 (relating to purchase, consumption, possession
- 15 or transportation of liquor or malt or brewed beverages) or
- 16 6310.3 (relating to carrying a false identification card), the
- 17 court, including a court not of record if it is exercising

- 1 jurisdiction pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S. § 1515(a) (relating to
- 2 jurisdiction and venue), shall order the operating privilege of
- 3 the person suspended[. A] and shall order the immediate
- 4 <u>surrender of the person's driver's license</u>. The surrendered
- 5 <u>license and a copy</u> of the order shall be transmitted to the
- 6 Department of Transportation.

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
