1 2 3	Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for confidential communications to licensed social workers.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 5945.2 Confidential communications to licensed social
9	workers.
10	(a) General ruleA person who has been licensed as a
11	social worker under the act of July 9, 1987 (P.L.220, No.39),
12	known as the Social Workers' Practice Act, shall not, without
13	the written consent of his client, be examined in any civil or
14	criminal matter as to any information acquired in the course of
15	his professional services in behalf of the client. The
16	confidential relations and communications between a licensed
17	social worker and his client shall be on the same basis as those
18	provided or prescribed by law between an attorney and client.

- 1 (b) Exception.--Notwithstanding subsection (a), a person
- 2 shall not be excused or prevented from complying with the act of
- 3 November 26, 1975 (P.L.438, No.124), known as the Child

4 Protective Services Law.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
