## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, requiring certain evidence to substantiate violations relating to purchase, consumption, 3 4 possession or transportation of liquor or malt or brewed 5 beverages by minors. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 6308 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 10 Purchase, consumption, possession or transportation of liquor or malt or brewed beverages. 11 12 13 (e) Evidence. -- The mere presence of a minor in or on premises where any liquor or malt or brewed beverage is in the 14 15 possession of or being consumed by another person, or in a vehicle in which any liquor or malt or brewed beverage is in the 16

possession of or is being transported by another person shall

- 1 not be sufficient evidence for a conviction or adjudication or
- 2 <u>other preadjudicative disposition under this section.</u>
- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 3
