1 2 3 4	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for aggravated assault on certain public officials and persons employed to assist or assisting said officials in the performance of duties.

б	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 2702(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 2702. Aggravated assault.
10	(a) Offense definedA person is guilty of aggravated
11	assault if he:

(1) attempts to cause serious bodily injury to another,
 or causes such injury intentionally, knowingly or recklessly
 under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the
 value of human life;

5 attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or (2) recklessly causes serious bodily injury to a police officer, 6 7 [or] firefighter, judge of any court in the unified judicial 8 system, the Attorney General of Pennsylvania, a deputy 9 attorney general, district attorney, assistant district attorney, State law enforcement official, local law 10 enforcement official, Federal law enforcement official, or 11 person employed to assist or assisting any law enforcement 12 13 official while in the performance of duty or as a result of his official position, or to an employee of an agency, 14 15 company or other entity engaged in public transportation, 16 while in the performance of duty;

17 (3) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly 18 causes bodily injury to a police officer, [or] firefighter, judge of any court in the unified judicial system, the 19 20 Attorney General of Pennsylvania, a deputy attorney general, 21 district attorney, assistant district attorney, State law enforcement official, local law enforcement official, Federal 22 23 law enforcement official, or person employed to assist or 24 assisting any law enforcement official while in the performance of duty or as a result of his official position; 25 26

26 (4) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly
27 causes bodily injury to another with a deadly weapon; or

(5) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly causes bodily injury to a teaching staff member, school board member, other employee or student of any elementary or 19890H1288B1481 - 2 - secondary publicly-funded educational institution, any elementary or secondary private school licensed by the Department of Education or any elementary or secondary parochial school while acting in the scope of his or her employment or because of his or her employment relationship to the school.
