## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 commissions shall be determined," establishing the Office of 21 Minority Health within the Department of Health; and 22 providing for its powers and duties.
- 23 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 24 hereby enacts as follows:
- 25 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 26 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a
- 27 section to read:

- 1 Section 2122. Office of Minority Health.--(a) There is
- 2 hereby established the Office of Minority Health within the
- 3 <u>Department of Health.</u>
- 4 (b) The Secretary of Health shall appoint the director of
- 5 the office, who shall serve at his pleasure. All other
- 6 professional and clerical staff shall be appointed under the act
- 7 of August 5, 1941 (P.L.752, No.286), known as the "Civil Service"
- 8 <u>Act."</u>
- 9 (c) The office is charged generally with the promotion of
- 10 <u>health amongst minority groups within this Commonwealth. To this</u>
- 11 <u>end the office shall:</u>
- 12 (1) Identify areas of need in minority health care and
- 13 <u>identify the resources of the various Federal, State and local</u>
- 14 governmental agencies, and the nonprofit and for-profit
- 15 <u>organizations which may be available to address those needs.</u>
- 16 (2) Coordinate the provision of health care to members of
- 17 minority groups given by public and private health care
- 18 agencies.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
