AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An
- 2 act concerning townships of the second class; and amending,
- 3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
- thereto," further providing for the composition of park or
- 5 recreation boards.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1903 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103,
- 9 No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, reenacted and
- 10 amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567) and amended July 2,
- 11 1953 (P.L.354, No.83), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 1903. Composition of Park or Recreation Boards.--
- 13 Park or recreation boards, when established, shall consist of
- 14 five or seven persons[, and when established in a township
- 15 having a school board, two of the members shall be members or
- 16 appointees of the school board]. The [other] members of such
- 17 boards shall be appointed by the supervisors, and shall serve
- 18 for terms of five years or until their successors are appointed,
- 19 except that the members of such board first appointed shall be

- 1 appointed for such terms that the term of not more than two
- 2 members shall expire annually thereafter. Members of such board
- 3 shall serve without pay. All persons appointed shall serve their
- 4 full terms unless voluntarily resigned or removed by the
- 5 supervisors for dereliction or neglect of duty. Vacancies in
- 6 such board occurring otherwise than by expiration of term shall
- 7 be for the unexpired term, and shall be filled in the same
- 8 manner as original appointments.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
