- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for permitting violation of
- 3 title.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1575 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1575. Permitting violation of title.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- No person shall authorize or knowingly
- 10 permit a motor vehicle owned by him or under his control to be
- 11 driven in violation of any of the provisions of this title.
- 12 (b) Penalty. -- Any person violating the provisions of
- 13 subsection (a) is guilty of [the same] a summary offense [as the
- 14 driver of such vehicle] and is subject to the same [penalties
- 15 including any suspension or revocation of the operating
- 16 privilege or the assessment of points] fine as the driver of the
- 17 <u>vehicle</u>. If the driver is convicted under section 3731 (relating
- 18 to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled substance)

- 1 or 3735 (relating to homicide by vehicle while driving under
- 2 <u>influence</u>), the person violating subsection (a) shall also be
- 3 <u>subject to suspension or revocation, as applicable, under</u>
- 4 <u>sections 1532 (relating to revocation or suspension of operating</u>
- 5 privilege) and 1542 (relating to revocation of habitual
- 6 <u>offender's license</u>).
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 7
