## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for drug trafficking 2 3 sentencing and penalties. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 7508(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 8 § 7508. Drug trafficking sentencing and penalties. 9 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any other provisions of 10 this or any other act to the contrary, the following provisions 11 shall apply: 12 13 (7) A person who is convicted of violating section 13(a)(30) of The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and 14 Cosmetic Act, in or within 1,000 feet of any public housing 15

shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to a mandatory minimum
