## AN ACT

- 1 Making appropriations to The Medical College of Pennsylvania,
- East Falls, Philadelphia.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The sum of \$3,083,000 \$3,233,000 is hereby
- 6 appropriated to The Medical College of Pennsylvania located in
- 7 East Falls, Philadelphia, for the fiscal year July 1, 1989, to
- 8 June 30, 1990, for instruction in the Doctor of Medicine
- 9 program.
- 10 Section 2. The sum of \$979,000 is hereby appropriated to The
- 11 Medical College of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, for the fiscal
- 12 year July 1, 1989, to June 30, 1990, for the general maintenance
- 13 of The Medical College of Pennsylvania, including the School of
- 14 Allied Health, and student aid.
- 15 Section 3. Payments to The Medical College of Pennsylvania
- 16 on account of the appropriations provided in sections 1 and 2

- 1 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the
- 2 basis of costs during the fiscal year.
- 3 Section 4. The Medical College of Pennsylvania shall provide
- 4 such information as may be necessary to carry out the provisions
- 5 of this act and in such form and manner as the Department of
- 6 Education shall prescribe.
- 7 Section 5. The Medical College of Pennsylvania shall report
- 8 its revenues and expenditures and present its financial
- 9 statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting
- 10 principles and procedures for educational institutions as set
- 11 forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the
- 12 "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State
- 13 System of Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-
- 14 State-Related Colleges and Universities."
- 15 Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1989, or
- 16 immediately, whichever is later.
