| 8 | Section 2. Payments to the Pennsylvania College of Optometry |

| 11 | costs during the fiscal year. |
| 12 | Section 3. The Pennsylvania College of Optometry shall |
| 13 | provide such information as may be necessary to carry out the |
| 14 | provisions of this act and in such form and manner as the |
| 15 | Department of Education shall prescribe. |
| 16 | Section 4. The Pennsylvania College of Optometry shall |

report its revenues and expenditures and present its financial

statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-Related Colleges and Universities."

7 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1989, or8 immediately, whichever is later.
