AN ACT

Amending the act of September 30, 1983 (P.L.160, No.39), 1 entitled "An act establishing salaries and compensation of 2 3 certain public officials including justices and judges of Statewide courts, judges of courts of common pleas, judges of 4 5 the Philadelphia Municipal Court, judges of the Philadelphia б Traffic Court, district justices and the Governor, the 7 Lieutenant Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor General, the Attorney General and certain other State 8 9 officers and the salary and certain expenses of the members 10 of the General Assembly; and repealing certain inconsistent 11 acts," providing for certain expenses for official business of the Attorney General, Auditor General and the State 12 13 Treasurer.

14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

15 hereby enacts as follows:

16 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of September 30, 1983

17 (P.L.160, No.39), known as the Public Official Compensation Law,

18 is amended by adding a subsection to read:

19 Section 3. Compensation of Governor and Lieutenant Governor;

20 State Treasurer; Auditor General; Attorney

21 General; and heads of departments.

- 1 (d) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
- 2 the Auditor General, Attorney General and the State Treasurer
- 3 each shall be entitled to receive up to \$15,000 per year in
- 4 vouchered expenses for official business.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
