## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for markings at deer crossing
- 3 areas.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 6116. Deer crossing areas.
- 9 (a) Posting. -- The department shall determine those portions
- 10 of highways where there are established deer crossings and
- 11 shall, in addition to other signs indicating the crossings,
- 12 install posts with reflectors along the side of the highway, at
- 13 such intervals as deemed appropriate, from the beginning to the
- 14 end of the deer crossing areas.
- 15 (b) Standards.--The color of the reflectors must be red. The

1 reflectors must maintain the following minimum reflective 2 <u>values:</u> 3 (1) For level terrain, 2 milli candella/lux (med/lx): (i) a vertical angle of observation of zero degree; 4 5 and (ii) a horizontal angle of observation of plus ten 6 7 degrees to minus ten degrees. (2) For sloping terrain, 0.4 milli candella/lux 8 9 (med/lx): 10 (i) a vertical angle of observation of 25 degrees; 11 and (ii) a horizontal angle of observation of plus ten 12 13 degrees to minus ten degrees. Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 14
