AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the number of court of common pleas judges in the First Judicial District and for the divisions of the Court of Common Pleas of Philadelphia County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Sections $911(a)$ and $951(a)$ of Title 42 of the
Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
§ 911. Courts of common pleas.
(a) General rule.--
(1) There shall be one court of common pleas for each

§ 951. Court divisions.
(a) Philadelphia County.--The Court of Common Pleas of
