AS AMENDED ON THIRD CONSIDERATION, IN SENATE, JUNE 29, 1990

## AN ACT

Making appropriations from the Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry to provide for the expenses of administering The Pennsylvania Workmen's Compensation Act and The Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act for the fiscal year July 1, 1990, to June 30, 1991, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. The sum of $\$ 19,911,000$ (A) SUBJECT TO THE
ADDITIONAI RESTRICTIONS UNDER SUBSECTION (B), THE SUM OF
$\$ 19,361,000$ THE SUM OF $\$ 19,789,000$, or as much thereof as may be <necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Workmen's

Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and
Industry for the payment of all salaries, wages and other
compensation and travel expenses, for contractual services and
other expenses necessary for the administration of the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as The Pennsylvania Workmen's Compensation Act, and the act of June 21, 1939
(P.L.566, No.284), known as The Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1990, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990.
(B) NO FUNDS FROM THE APPROPRIATION IN SUBSECTION (A) SHAII <BE USED TO PAY FOR ANY DIRECT COST TRANSEERS BETWEEN THF APPROPRIATION IN SUBSECTION (A) AND THE APPRORRIATION FOR GENERAI GOVERNMENT OPERATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1990, or immediately, whichever is later.
