SENATOR TILGHMAN, APPROPRIATIONS, IN SENATE, RE-REPORTED AS AMENDED, JUNE 29, 1990

AN ACT

1 Making appropriations to the Trustees of the University of
2 Pennsylvania.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be
6 necessary, are hereby appropriated to the Trustees of the
7 University of Pennsylvania for the fiscal year July 1, 1990, to
8 June 30, 1991, for the purposes and in the amounts as shown:

12 Section 2. Payments to the University of Pennsylvania on
13 account of the appropriations for the items provided in section
14 1 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the
15 basis of costs during the fiscal year.

16 Section 3. The University of Pennsylvania shall provide such
17 information as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of
18 this act and in such form and manner as the Department of
19 Education shall prescribe.

20 Section 4. The University of Pennsylvania shall report its
21 revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements
22 in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and
23 procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the
24 "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth
25 of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of
26 Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-
27 Related Colleges and Universities."

28 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1990, or
29 immediately, whichever is later.
