AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 18, 1984 (P.L.391, No.82), entitled "An 2 act regulating continuing-care facilities; imposing duties 3 upon the Insurance Commissioner; requiring certificate of authority; revocation of certificates; regulating disclosure 4 5 statements; advertisement; regulating financial reserves; requiring escrows; regulating residents' agreements; 7 establishing an advisory council; granting right of organization; regulating liquidation and rehabilitation; 8 9 imposing civil liability; providing for the right to 10 investigate and subpoena, liens, cross-collateralization, 11 cease and desist orders and audits; imposing fees and 12 regulations; and making criminal penalties, " regulating 13 escrow deposits. 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 14 of the act of June 18, 1984 (P.L.391, 16 17 No.82), known as the Continuing-Care Provider Registration and 18 Disclosure Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read: 19 Section 14. Resident's agreement. 20 21 (q) No resident shall be required to post a sum in excess of
- 22 two months' fees to be deposited as escrow with a facility for

- 1 <u>security</u>. Money deposited as escrow shall earn interest payable
- 2 <u>annually to the resident.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
