AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), entitled
 "An act relating to cities of the third class; and amending,
 revising, and consolidating the law relating thereto,"
 providing for the reappointment of formerly employed police
 officers.

 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 4401 of the act of June 23, 1931
- 9 (P.L.932, No.317), known as The Third Class City Code, reenacted
- 10 and amended June 28, 1951 (P.L.662, No.164), is amended to read:
- 11 Section 4401. Examinations Required of All Appointees. -- (a)
- 12 No person or persons may be appointed to any position whatever
- 13 in the police department, or in the engineering department or
- 14 electrical department, except as otherwise provided by law, or
- 15 in the position of building inspector, or as health officers
- 16 other than registered physicians, or as sanitary policemen or
- 17 inspectors of the health department, without having first passed
- 18 all the examinations hereinafter provided for, and having been
- 19 appointed in the manner and according to the terms and

- 1 provisions and conditions of this article.
- 2 (b) Any vacancy in an existing position in the police
- 3 <u>department which occurs as a result of retirement, resignation,</u>
- 4 <u>disability or death may be filled by council by the</u>
- 5 reappointment or reinstatement of a former employe of the police
- 6 <u>department who had previously complied with the terms and</u>
- 7 provisions and conditions of this article, and who has complied
- 8 with the act of June 18, 1974 (P.L.359, No.120), referred to as
- 9 the Municipal Police Education and Training Law. No further
- 10 <u>examination other than a physical examination as directed by the</u>
- 11 police civil service board shall be required in any case of
- 12 <u>reappointment or reinstatement.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
