## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for wiretapping in
- 3 relation to the use of cordless telephones.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The definitions of "electronic communication,"
- 7 "oral communication" and "wire communication" in section 5702 of
- 8 Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended
- 9 to read:
- 10 § 5702. Definitions.
- 11 As used in this chapter, the following words and phrases
- 12 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 \* \* \*
- 15 "Electronic communication." Any transfer of signs, signals,
- 16 writing, images, sounds, data or intelligence of any nature
- 17 transmitted in whole or in part by a wire, radio,
- 18 electromagnetic, photoelectronic or photo-optical system,

- 1 except:
- 2 (1) [The radio portion of a cordless telephone
- 3 communication that is transmitted between the cordless
- 4 telephone handset and the base unit.
- 5 (2)] Any wire or oral communication.
- 6 [(3)] (2) Any communication made through a tone-only
- 7 paging device.
- 8 [(4)] (3) Any communication from a tracking device (as
- 9 defined in this section).
- 10 \* \* \*
- "Oral communication." Any oral communication uttered by a
- 12 person possessing an expectation that such communication is not
- 13 subject to interception under circumstances justifying such
- 14 expectation. When a person orally communicates in the use of a
- 15 cordless or cellular telephone, he can reasonably expect that
- 16 <u>such communication is not subject to interception any more than</u>
- 17 if such communication was in the use of a conventional
- 18 <u>telephone</u>. The term does not include any electronic
- 19 communication.

- 21 "Wire communication." Any aural transfer made in whole or in
- 22 part through the use of facilities for the transmission of
- 23 communication by wire, cable or other like connection between
- 24 the point of origin and the point of reception, including the
- 25 use of such a connection in a switching station, furnished or
- 26 operated by a telephone, telegraph or radio company for hire as
- 27 a communication common carrier. The term [does not include]
- 28 <u>includes</u> the radio portion of a cordless telephone communication
- 29 transmitted between the cordless telephone handset and the base
- 30 unit.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
