- 3 WHEREAS, The USTA National Amateur Clay Court and West Penn
- 4 Tennis Championships will be held in Mt. Lebanon, Pennsylvania,
- 5 July 8 through 16, 1989; and
- 6 WHEREAS, This is the 100th Anniversary of these
- 7 championships; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The goal of this event in 1989 is fundraising for
- 9 the Allegheny County Special Olympics; and
- 10 WHEREAS, This is the longest consecutive running tennis
- 11 tournament in the United States; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The site of the tournament, the Tressel Municipal
- 13 Tennis Center in Mt. Lebanon, was in 1985 named the Outstanding
- 14 Public Tennis Facility in America by the United States Tennis
- 15 Association; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Many previous participants have gone on to become
- 17 "big name" professionals, such as: Bill Tildon, Roscoe Tanner,
