A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing teachers selected to the Salute to Teaching Program.

2 WHEREAS, Teachers provide the key to learning for all the
3 young citizens of the nation; and

4 WHEREAS, Excellent teachers are the most important resource
5 that schools have; and

6 WHEREAS, This Nation and this Commonwealth need to honor,
7 reward and retain their excellent teachers; and

8 WHEREAS, In the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania there are
9 presently 105,415 full-time public school teachers and 19,839
10 full-time faculty teaching in 3,268 public schools and 148
11 colleges and universities, and these teachers are educating
12 1,655,271 students in our public schools and 556,927 students
13 enrolled in higher education; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives acknowledge these
15 excellent teachers for their dedication; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives salute in
17 particular, those Pennsylvania teachers who have been selected

1 by their peers through the Salute to Teaching Program of the
2 Pennsylvania Academy for the Profession of Teaching as examples
3 to all citizens of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and be it
4 further

5 RESOLVED, That the members of the House of Representatives
6 commend them as worthy exemplars of the profession of teaching
7 and as persons especially important to their profession, to
8 society and to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
