AN ACT

- 1 Making appropriations from the Professional Licensure
- 2 Augmentation Account and from restricted revenue accounts
- 3 within the General Fund to the Department of State for use by
- 4 the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs in
- 5 support of the professional licensure boards assigned
- 6 thereto.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The sum of \$12,042,000, or as much thereof as may
- 10 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Professional
- 11 Licensure Augmentation Account within the General Fund to the
- 12 Department of State for the operation of the Bureau of
- 13 Professional and Occupational Affairs for the fiscal year July
- 14 1, 1989, to June 30, 1990.
- 15 Section 2. (a) The sum of \$1,893,000, or as much thereof as
- 16 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted
- 17 receipts account of the State Board of Medicine, as authorized
- 18 by section 907(a) of the act of October 15, 1975 (P.L.390,
- 19 No.111), known as the Health Care Services Malpractice Act, for

- 1 the operation of said board for the fiscal year July 1, 1989, to
- 2 June 30, 1990.
- 3 (b) The sum of \$436,000, or as much thereof as may be
- 4 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted receipts
- 5 account of the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine, as
- 6 authorized by section 907(b) of the Health Care Services
- 7 Malpractice Act, for the operation of said board for the fiscal
- 8 year July 1, 1989, to June 30, 1990.
- 9 (c) The sum of \$127,000, or as much thereof as may be
- 10 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted receipts
- 11 account of the State Board of Podiatry, as authorized by section
- 12 907(c) of the Health Care Services Malpractice Act, for the
- 13 operation of said board for the fiscal year July 1, 1989, to
- 14 June 30, 1990.
- 15 (d) Each appropriation listed in subsections (a), (b) and
- 16 (c) shall not be treated as an augmentation to the Department of
- 17 State, general government appropriation, or any other
- 18 appropriation, but shall be treated and accounted for as
- 19 separate appropriations respectively.
- 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1989, or
- 21 immediately, whichever is later.
