STATE AID THE [LESSER] GREATER OF THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS:

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- 21 (b) Distribution of foreign fire insurance tax moneys.--
- 22 (1) The foreign fire insurance premium tax amount

firefighters shall be allocated no later than September 30 to

28 (2) The foreign fire insurance premium tax amount 29 applicable to a municipality served solely by volunteer

firefighters shall be paid to the municipality, which shall

- within 60 days of the date of the receipt of the moneys from
  the State Treasurer pay the amount received to the relief
  association fund of the fire department or departments, or
  fire company or companies, now existing or hereafter
  organized, inside or outside of the municipality, which is or
  are actively engaged in the service of the municipality and
  duly recognized by the governing body of the municipality.
- 8 The foreign fire insurance premium tax amount 9 applicable to a municipality served by both paid firefighters 10 and volunteer firefighters shall be divided into the portion applicable to paid firefighters and the portion applicable to 11 12 volunteer firefighters. The division of the amount shall be 13 based on the proportion of the actual fire protection service in the municipality provided by each type of firefighter as 14 15 certified by the municipality, except that in no event shall the portion applicable to paid firefighters be less than the 16 17 smaller of the amount of foreign fire insurance premium tax 18 applicable to the municipality or [the revised amount of 19 general municipal pension system State aid per unit for the 20 previous year determined pursuant to section 402, per paid firefighter, which for 1985 shall be deemed to be] \$1,100 per 21 22 paid firefighter. The ultimate distribution of the portion 23 applicable to paid firefighters shall be governed by 24 paragraph (1). The distribution of the portion applicable to 25 volunteer firefighters shall be governed by paragraph (2). 26 Section 2. This act shall apply to distributions of the foreign fire insurance premium tax made after January 1, 1989 27
- 29 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
