A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Designating a flag to memorialize volunteer firefighters who  
2 were killed in the line of duty.

3 WHEREAS, Volunteer firefighters throughout this Commonwealth  
4 have discussed the commendability of having a flag to  
5 memorialize comrades who were killed in the line of duty; and

6 WHEREAS, After due consideration of the advisability of  
7 having such a flag, the Adams County Volunteer Firefighters  
8 designed and manufactured a volunteer firefighters' memorial  
9 flag; and

10 WHEREAS, The Firemen's Legislative Federation of Pennsylvania  
11 has endorsed the flag designed and manufactured by the Adams  
12 County Volunteer Firefighters; and

13 WHEREAS, This flag will serve as the recognized, singular  
14 memorial flag for those volunteer firefighters who have died in  
15 the line of duty in this Commonwealth; and

16 WHEREAS, This flag has a field of blue with a gold keystone  
17 in the center which surrounds a Maltese cross, and at the bottom  
18 of the blue field, in gold capital letters, there is sewn the

1 phrase "Lest We Forget"; therefore be it

2       RESOLVED (the House of Representatives concurring), That the  
3 General Assembly thank the Adams County Volunteer Firefighters  
4 for their artistic and civic-minded endeavors and commend the  
5 Firemen's Legislative Federation of Pennsylvania for its  
6 spirited support of the Volunteer Firefighters' Memorial Flag;  
7 and be it further

8       RESOLVED, That the General Assembly recognize this flag as  
9 the official Volunteer Firefighters' Memorial Flag of this  
10 Commonwealth.
