A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Directing the Joint State Government Commission to develop a
2 plan for the establishment of a Pennsylvania Family Court.

3 WHEREAS, House Bill 1023, Printer's Number 3110, entitled "An
4 act amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania
5 Consolidated Statutes, adding provisions relating to domestic
6 relations; making conforming amendments to Titles 18 and 42; and
7 repealing certain acts and parts of acts supplied by the act or
8 otherwise obsolete," is a codification of the laws of this
9 Commonwealth relating to domestic relations; and

10 WHEREAS, House Bill 1023 received final passage by the House
11 of Representatives on March 12, 1990; and

12 WHEREAS, House Bill 1023 was referred to the Judiciary
13 Committee of the Senate on March 19, 1990; and

14 WHEREAS, Consideration should be given to the establishment
15 of a Pennsylvania Family Court which would exercise jurisdiction
16 over all matters included in House Bill 1023; therefore be it

17 RESOLVED (the House of Representatives concurring), That the

- 1 General Assembly direct the Joint State Government Commission to
- 2 develop a plan for the establishment of a Pennsylvania Family
- 3 Court to preside over all matters included in House Bill 1023.
