## AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing certain municipalities situated within counties of
- 2 the second class A to impose additional taxes for various
- 3 purposes.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Additional tax authorization.
- 7 (a) General rule. -- The governing body of any municipality,
- 8 as defined in section 2, which is situated within the boundaries
- 9 of a county of the second class A shall have the power and may,
- 10 by ordinance or resolution, levy upon all real property and upon
- 11 all occupations, and may collect annually, any or all of the
- 12 following additional taxes:
- 13 (1) A tax, not exceeding five mills, for the purpose of
- 14 providing trash removal services for the municipality.
- 15 (2) A tax, not exceeding five mills, for the purpose of
- 16 providing liability insurance for the municipality.
- 17 (3) A tax, not exceeding five mills, for the purpose of
- 18 providing police support services for the municipality.

- 1 (b) Additional power.--The power granted in section 1 shall
- 2 be in addition to and not subject to the limitations in section
- 3 1709 of the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as
- 4 The First Class Township Code; section 905 Of the act of May 1,
- 5 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code;
- 6 and section 1302 of the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656,
- 7 No.581), known as The Borough Code.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Governing body." The council of a borough, the board of
- 13 township commissioners in a township of the first class or the
- 14 board of township supervisors in a township of the second class.
- 15 "Municipality." Any borough, township of the first class or
- 16 township of the second class situated within the boundaries of a
- 17 county of the second class A.
- 18 Section 3. Effective date.
- 19 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
