## AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An  
2 act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public  
3 welfare laws of the Commonwealth," further providing for  
4 eligibility for subsidized child day care.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known  
8 as the Public Welfare Code, is amended by adding a section to  
9 read:

10 Section 494. Subsidized Child Day Care.--(a) In determining  
11 eligibility for subsidized child day care for parents or  
12 caretakers receiving vocational training, such training shall be  
13 deemed to include all of the following:

14 (1) Four-year baccalaureate degree programs at a college or  
15 university.

16 (2) Postgraduate degree programs at a college or university.

17 (3) English as a second language programs of fewer than

1 twenty hours per week.

2 (4) General Educational Development (GED) programs of fewer  
3 than twenty hours per week.

4 (b) Any regulation of the department inconsistent with  
5 subsection (a) is hereby abrogated to the extent of such  
6 inconsistency.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
