AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An
- act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- 3 welfare laws of the Commonwealth, " further providing for
- 4 eligibility for subsidized child day care.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
- 8 as the Public Welfare Code, is amended by adding a section to
- 9 read:
- 10 Section 494. Subsidized Child Day Care. -- (a) In determining
- 11 eligibility for subsidized child day care for parents or
- 12 caretakers receiving vocational training, such training shall be
- 13 deemed to include all of the following:
- 14 (1) Four-year baccalaureate degree programs at a college or
- 15 <u>university</u>.
- 16 (2) Postgraduate degree programs at a college or university.
- 17 (3) English as a second language programs of fewer than

- 1 <u>twenty hours per week.</u>
- (4) General Educational Development (GED) programs of fewer 2
- 3 than twenty hours per week.
- 4 (b) Any regulation of the department inconsistent with
- 5 <u>subsection (a) is hereby abrogated to the extent of such</u>
- 6 <u>inconsistency</u>.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 7
