## AN ACT

$     \begin{array}{r}       1 \\       2 \\       3 \\       4 \\       5 \\       6 \\       7 \\       8 \\       9 \\       10 \\       11 \\       12 \\       13 \\     \end{array} $	Amending the act of March 1, 1988 (P.L.82, No.16), entitled "An act providing for the establishment, implementation and administration of the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority; imposing powers and duties on a board of trustees; transferring the rights, powers, duties and obligations of the Water Facilities Loan Board to the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority; providing for the issuance of notes and bonds; providing for financial assistance and for a comprehensive water facilities plan; authorizing a referendum to incur indebtedness; making an appropriation; and making repeals," providing for the waiver of letters of no prejudice for certain applications for financial assistance.
14	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
15	hereby enacts as follows:
16	Section 1. Section 10 of the act of March 1, 1988 (P.L.82,
17	No.16), known as the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment
18	Authority Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read:
19	Section 10. Financial assistance.
20	* * *
21	(o) Limited waiver of letter of no prejudice
22	(1) Any requirement that an applicant obtain a letter of
23	no prejudice shall not apply to any project which meets the

1	requirements of paragraph (2). Applications for financial
2	assistance for projects under paragraph (2) shall not be
3	rejected or subject to any penalty for failure to apply for
4	<u>or obtain a letter of no prejudice.</u>
5	(2) The provisions of paragraph (1) shall apply to any
6	project on which construction was initiated on or after March
7	1, 1988, and prior to February 28, 1989, and which meets any
8	of the following requirements:
9	(i) The project was required to be initiated to
10	comply with a Federal or State regulatory order.
11	(ii) The project was required to be initiated to
12	attend to some demonstrable public health or safety
13	emergency.
14	(iii) The project was required to be initiated to
15	make possible an economic development project which will
16	retain existing jobs or create new jobs where the
17	opportunity for that economic development project may be
18	lost because of delay.
19	Section 2. This act shall be retroactive to March 1, 1988.
20	Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
