## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 30, 1937 (P.L.115, No.40), entitled 2 "An act to provide for the permanent personal registration of 3 electors in cities of the first class as a condition of their right to vote at elections and primaries, and their 5 enrollment as members of political parties as a further condition of their right to vote at primaries; prescribing 7 certain procedure for the conduct of elections and primaries 8 and the challenge and proof of qualifications of electors; 9 and prescribing the powers and duties of citizens, parties, 10 bodies of electors, registration commissions, commissioners, 11 registrars, inspectors of registration and other appointees 12 of registration commission, election officers, municipal 13 officers, departments and bureaus, police officers, courts, judges, prothonotaries, sheriffs, county commissioners, peace 14 officers, county treasurers, county controllers, registrars 15 16 of vital statistics, real estate brokers, rental agents, 17 certain public service companies, persons, firms, and corporations operating vehicles for moving furniture and 18 19 household goods, and boards of school directors; and imposing 20 penalties, "providing for voter registration in first class 21 cities in conjunction with motor vehicle driver's license 22 registration.

- 23 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 24 hereby enacts as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The act of March 30, 1937 (P.L.115, No.40), known
- 2 as The First Class City Permanent Registration Act, is amended
- 3 by adding a section to read:
- 4 <u>Section 21.1. Motor Vehicle Driver's License Voter</u>
- 5 Registration Application. -- (a) (1) In addition to any other
- 6 method provided under law, each application for a driver's
- 7 <u>license</u>, as defined in 75 Pa.C.S. § 102, and (RELATING TO
- 8 <u>DEFINITIONS</u>), any renewal application AND ANY IDENTIFICATION <-
- 9 CARD APPLICATION ISSUED UNDER 75 PA.C.S. § 1510(B) (RELATING TO
- 10 ISSUANCE AND CONTENT OF DRIVER'S LICENSE) shall serve as an
- 11 <u>application to register to vote.</u>
- 12 (2) An application for voter registration submitted to the
- 13 <u>Department of Transportation under this section shall be</u>
- 14 considered as updating any previous voter registration
- 15 <u>information</u> by the applicant.
- 16 (3) Each driver's license application shall include a box or
- 17 other device to permit an applicant to decline to register to
- 18 vote. Use of this information for any other purpose is
- 19 prohibited.
- 20 (b) (1) The Department of Transportation shall include a
- 21 voter registration application form as part of an application
- 22 for a driver's license.
- 23 (2) The content of the driver's license/voter registration
- 24 application shall be determined and prescribed by the Secretary
- 25 <u>of the Commonwealth and the Secretary of Transportation through</u>
- 26 <u>regulation</u>.
- 27 (3) The voter registration application portion of an
- 28 application for a State motor vehicle driver's license: (i) may
- 29 not require any information which duplicates information
- 30 required in the driver's license portion of the form, other than

- 1 <u>a second signature or other information as necessary; (ii) shall</u>
- 2 <u>include a means by which an applicant may decline to register to</u>
- 3 <u>vote; (iii) may require only the minimum amount of information</u>
- 4 necessary to prevent duplicate voter registration, to enable the
- 5 commission to assess the eligibility of the applicant and to
- 6 <u>administer voter registration and other parts of the election</u>
- 7 process; (iv) shall include a declaration of eligibility; (v)
- 8 shall require the signature of the applicant, under penalty of
- 9 perjury; and (vi) shall be made available to the appropriate
- 10 registration commission.
- 11 (c) Any change of address form submitted in accordance with
- 12 State law for purposes of State motor vehicle driver's license
- 13 shall serve as notification of change of address for voter
- 14 registration with respect to elections for State office for the
- 15 applicant involved if the applicant states on the form that the
- 16 change of address is for voter registration purposes as well as
- 17 for purposes of the license to operate a motor vehicle.
- 18 (d) (1) The Department of Transportation shall forward the
- 19 completed voter registration information to the Department of
- 20 <u>State or the appropriate commission as determined by regulation.</u>
- 21 (2) Upon receipt of the completed voter registration
- 22 information from the Department of Transportation or the
- 23 Department of State, the commission shall make an entry of the
- 24 <u>date received on each application and process the application</u>
- 25 under section 20.3. No applicant shall be deemed eliqible to
- 26 vote until the commission has received and processed the
- 27 application.
- 28 (e) The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall have the primary
- 29 responsibility for implementing and enforcing the driver's
- 30 license voter registration system created under this section.

- The Secretary of the Commonwealth, in conjunction CONSULTATION 1
- with the Secretary of the Department of Transportation, shall 2
- 3 MAY promulgate rules and regulations for implementing and <---
- 4 enforcing this section.
- 5 (F) A PERSON WHO IS NOT A QUALIFIED ELECTOR AND WHO HAS
- APPLIED FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE UNDER 75 PA.C.S. § 1503(C) 6
- 7 (RELATING TO PERSONS INELIGIBLE FOR LICENSING) IS INELIGIBLE TO
- 8 REGISTER TO VOTE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 9 (G) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE SHALL REIMBURSE THE DEPARTMENT
- 10 OF TRANSPORTATION FOR COSTS INCURRED IN OPERATING THE VOTER
- 11 REGISTRATION PROGRAM, AS DETERMINED IN A MEMORANDUM OF
- 12 UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENTS.
- 13 SECTION 2. NOTHING IN THIS ACT SHALL PRECLUDE THE SECRETARY
- OF THE COMMONWEALTH FROM IMPLEMENTING THE DRIVER'S LICENSE VOTER 14
- 15 REGISTRATION PROGRAM, ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 1, BEFORE
- JANUARY 1, 1993. IF FEDERAL LEGISLATION PASSES RELATING TO THIS 16
- 17 ACT, THIS ACT SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE
- 18 FEDERAL LEGISLATION.
- 19 Section 2 3. This act shall take effect January 1, 1993.
