AN ACT

Making an appropriation from a restricted revenue account within 2 the General Fund to the Office of Consumer Advocate. AMENDING THE ACT OF JULY 1, 1990 (P.L. , NO.7A), ENTITLED, AS AMENDED, "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH, THE PUBLIC DEBT AND FOR THE 6 7 PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1990, TO JUNE 30, 1991, AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1990; 9 TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE STATE LOTTERY FUND, THE 10 11 PENNSYLVANIA ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION FUND, THE ENERGY 12 CONSERVATION AND ASSISTANCE FUND, THE HAZARDOUS MATERIAL 13 RESPONSE FUND, THE STATE STORES FUND AND THE EMERGENCY 14 MEDICAL SERVICES OPERATING FUND TO THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT; 15 TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE JUDICIAL COMPUTER SYSTEM 16 AUGMENTATION ACCOUNT TO THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT; TO PROVIDE 17 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE MOTOR LICENSE FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1990, TO JUNE 30, 1991, FOR THE PROPER OPERATION 18 OF THE SEVERAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND THE 19 20 PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE AUTHORIZED TO SPEND MOTOR LICENSE FUND MONEYS; AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF FEDERAL 21 22 FUNDS TO THE EXECUTIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE 23 COMMONWEALTH AND FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF RESTRICTED RECEIPTS 24 ACCOUNTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1990, TO JUNE 30, 1991, AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND REMAINING UNPAID AT 25 THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1990," 26 27 INCREASING AND DECREASING CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS TO THE 28 EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT.
