 16 AUGMENTATION ACCOUNT TO THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT; TO PROVIDE
 17 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE MOTOR LICENSE FUND FOR THE FISCAL
 18 YEAR JULY 1, 1990, TO JUNE 30, 1991, FOR THE PROPER OPERATION
