AN ACT

- Amending the act of November 1, 1971 (P.L.495, No.113), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the compensation of county officers in counties of the second through eighth 3 classes, for compensation of district attorneys in cities and counties of the first class, for the disposition of fees, for filing of bonds in certain cases and for duties of certain 7 officers," limiting certain salary increases. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 10.1(e) of the act of November 1, 1971 (P.L.495, No.113), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for 11 12 the compensation of county officers in counties of the second 13 through eighth classes, for compensation of district attorneys in cities and counties of the first class, for the disposition 14 15 of fees, for filing of bonds in certain cases and for duties of 16 certain officers," reenacted and amended October 7, 1976 17 (P.L.1101, No.223) and amended December 18, 1984 (P.L.1067, 18 No.212), is amended to read: 19 Section 10.1.
- 20 (e) Any salary increase shall be on a percentage basis and

- 1 applied equally to all county officials except that the county
- 2 commissioners may provide a greater percentage salary increase
- 3 to the lowest paid county official, other than the jury
- 4 commissioners or county auditor, until his salary is equal to
- 5 the other county officials except the jury commissioners, county
- 6 auditors, district attorneys and county commissioners.
- 7 Percentage salary increases provided for in this subsection
- 8 shall not apply to part-time district attorneys whose salaries
- 9 <u>are provided for in section 5 or to district attorneys of cities</u>
- 10 or counties of the first class whose salaries are provided for
- 11 <u>in section 5.1.</u>
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
