AN ACT

Amending the act of November 4, 1983 (P.L.217, No.63), entitled "An act establishing a program of limited pharmaceutical assistance for the elderly; granting powers to and imposing duties on the Department of Aging; establishing a payment system; making provisions for funding; providing for reports; and fixing penalties for violations of the pharmaceutical assistance program," further defining "maximum annual income."

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. The definition of "maximum annual income" in

12 section 3 of the act of November 4, 1983 (P.L.217, No.63), known

13 as the Pharmaceutical Assistance Contract for the Elderly Act,

17 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall

have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
context clearly indicates otherwise:

4 "Maximum annual income." Annual income as determined by the department. Such amount shall not exceed \$12,000 in the case of 5 single persons nor \$15,000 in the case of the combined annual 6 income of married persons. For years beginning after December 7 8 31, 1990, the term shall mean, for a single individual, \$12,000 9 base income plus all adjustments to Social Security payments due to cost-of-living increases and, for a married couple, \$15,000 10 base income plus all adjustments to Social Security payments due 11 12 to cost-of-living increases. * * * 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 14
