AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled

"An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; 6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; 8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 9 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 10 elections," further providing for absentee ballots. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 1308(a) of the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, 15 amended December 11, 1968 (P.L.1183, No.375), is amended to 16 17 read: 18 Section 1308. Canvassing of Official Absentee Ballots.--19 The county boards of election, upon receipt of official absentee ballots in such envelopes, shall safely keep the same 20 in sealed or locked containers until they distribute same to the 21 22 appropriate local election districts in a manner prescribed by

- 1 the Secretary of the Commonwealth. Official absentee ballots
- 2 received later than 5:00 o'clock P. M. on the Friday immediately
- 3 preceding the primary or election day shall be immediately
- 4 <u>canvassed</u> by the county board of elections.
- 5 The county board of elections shall then distribute the
- 6 absentee ballots received prior to 5:00 o'clock P. M. on the
- 7 Friday immediately preceding the primary or election day,
- 8 unopened, to the absentee voter's respective election district
- 9 concurrently with the distribution of the other election
- 10 supplies. Absentee ballots shall be canvassed immediately and
- 11 continuously without interruption until completed after the
- 12 close of the polls on the day of the election in each election
- 13 district. The results of the canvass of the absentee ballots
- 14 shall then be included in and returned to the county board with
- 15 the returns of that district. No absentee ballot shall be
- 16 counted which is received in the office of the county board of
- 17 election later than [five] 8:00 o'clock P. M. on the [Friday
- 18 immediately preceding the] primary or November election day.

- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
