AN ACT

- 1 Providing continued insurance coverage for veterans of foreign 2 wars upon return from active duty.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the GI Insurance
- 7 Guaranteed Coverage Act.
- 8 Section 2. Coverage.
- 9 All insurance companies within this Commonwealth shall
- 10 reinstate, upon payment of the required premium, all casualty,
- 11 auto, health, accident or life insurance which was in effect and
- 12 good standing prior to the departure of any member of the United
- 13 States Armed Forces who served during a period of a foreign war
- 14 as declared by the President and Congress of the United States.
- 15 Section 3. Eligibility.

- 1 To be eligible for continuation of coverage, military
- 2 personnel must have served in a foreign conflict, which required
- 3 an absence from the country, and must exhibit a good prior
- 4 record of credit and risk management.
- 5 Section 4. Effective date.
- 6 This act shall take effect in 90 days.
